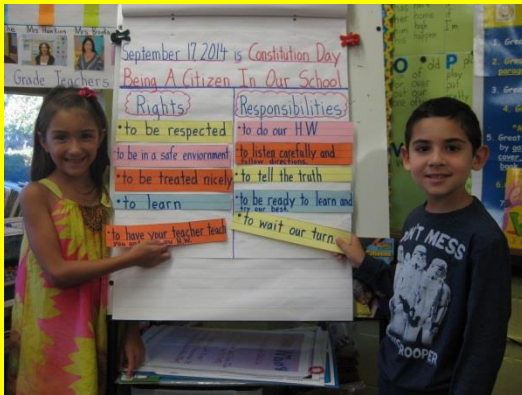


Celebrating Constitution Day!
